Once you have found all of the images, go to a Visitor Services desk for your prize!

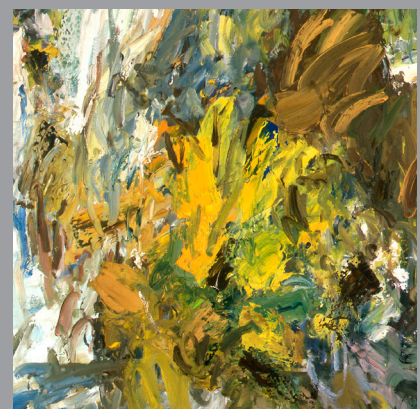
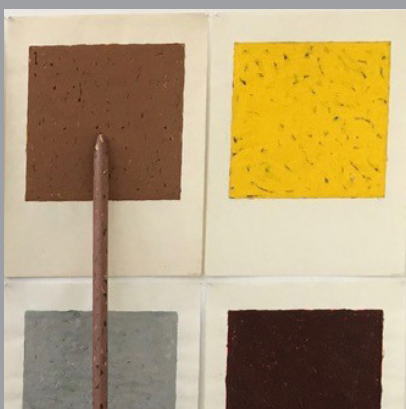
